



Notice of race

IOM Nordic Championship 2019

Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th of September 2019

1. Organizing Authority

The 2019 IOM Class Nordic Championship is organized by Stenungsund Segelsällskap (STSS), Stockholms Radiosegelsällskap (SRSS) and Enmeterförbundet (SWE IOM-NCA).

2. Venue

The championship will be held at Skärhamn, on the island of Tjörn north of Göteborg.

3. Rules

- 3.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), as amended by the RRS Appendix E, this Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the International IOM Class Rules and The Equipment Rules of Sailing.
- 3.2 In case of umpired fleet racing, IRSA Addendum Q shall apply.

- 3.3 If the fleet is divided into two or more heats Heat Management System 2016 shall apply.
- 3.4 The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

4. Eligibility requirements

- 4.1 To be entitled to participate in championships sanctioned by the Swedish Sports Federation, each competitor shall comply with ISAF Regulation 19.
- 4.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 4.3 Swedish competitors shall hold a valid license for competition on a national level in accordance with Swedish Sailing Federation regulations.

5. Entries

- 5.1 The number of competitors is limited to 36. Each Nordic NCA is allocated 8 places according to actual NCA ranking order. Non Nordic entries are allocated 4 places.
- 5.2 Entries, according to actual NCA ranking order, shall be submitted by each Nordic NCA by mail to Christer Sörvik, Christer2000@hotmail.com, no later than Tuesday, August 6th 2019. Each entry shall include Name, Sail Number, Club, e-mail address and mobile telephone number.
- 5.3 The organizer will publish all competitors on the STSS-NC-site that meets the stage 1 allocation criteria and the total limit of max 36 participants. The organizer will take into account the submitted NCA listing and previous results in Swedish and Nordic Championships.
- 5.4 The entry fee is 600 SEK.
- 5.5 Each competitor shall no later than Tuesday August 20th confirm their participation by making their registration on the STSS-NC-site and by paying the entry fee using the STSS registration module, where you can pay by credit card. Each entry will only be valid subject that the entry fee is paid on time.
- 5.6 After stage 1, if remaining places are still available, additional competitors can register and pay the entry fee. The latest date for these entries and payments is Friday September 13th.
- 5.7 Late entries are possible to register by September 20th at the latest. The entry fee is then raised by 100 SEK.

6. Time schedule

Tuesday, August 6th

Closing date for entries submitted from each NCA. Competitors list is then directly published on the STSS-NC-site.

Tuesday, August 20th

Final closing date for participant registration and entry fee payment on the STSS-NC-site.

Friday, September 13th

Final closing date for additional entries. Late entries possible until Sept 20th at a higher fee.

Friday, September 27th

If possible the organizer will see to that competitors can practice during the late Friday afternoon. Information about this will be posted one week before the race weekend on the STSS-NC-site.

9:15 Skippers meeting and briefing

9:30 First warning signal

Lunch break when suitable

17:00 No heat will be started after this time

Sunday, September 29th

09:00 First warning signal

Lunch break when suitable

Price giving ceremony will commence as soon as possible after the results are calculated and presented

6.1 Lunch and refreshments during both days of the event are included in the entry fee.

7. Registration and measurement checks

7.1 Boats, together with their valid measurement certificates shall be presented for registration before 9.00 on September 28th However, the Race Committee may extend the time for registration and event measurement if there is a valid reason to do so. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has been registered and and has passed event measurement.

Any boat can be checked at any time during the event.

8. Sailing Instructions

8.1 The sailing instructions will be published on the STSS-NC-site no later than September 25th.

9. Race format and scoring

- 9.1 The Racing system will be HMS 2016. Fleet racing will be considered as an option whenever fewer than 20 boats are starting at any race scheduled.
- 9.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

10. Racing area

- 10.1 The racing area will be chosen and published on STSS-NC-site by the organisers latest on Thursday, September 26th 2019.

11. Frequencies:

- 11.1 Permitted frequencies are: 27MHz, 35MHz and 2.4GHz. Bring at least two frequencies if you are using 27MHz or 35MHz (Not applicable for 2.4 GHz users).

12. Prizes

- 12.1 Prizes will be given by a total number equal to one for every five competitor having started in the regatta.
- 12.2 Nordic Championship plaque and titles will be awarded to Nordic competitors.
